The sudden shift to online education is a challenge and opportunity alike. At 'Plagiarism Across Europe and Beyond', a conference hosted by the European Network for Academic Integrity (ENAI), the global EdTech community discussed challenges and opportunities.

- **Connectivity:** Solutions and integrations, with standards like LTI (Learning Tool Interoperability) being important to ensure seamless workflows for both instructors and students

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- **Media Enrichment:** Interactive whiteboards, video assisted learning, gamification among other solutions to engage students self-motivation and learning
- **Student Centered Learning:** Focus on students needs through blended learning, and more inclusion-oriented learning environments

Given the opportunities that are provided through technologies, the community agreed that digital tools were useless without further training and use case scenarios for the faculty. Also, with a digitization of education came another push for ensuring fair and equal education standards ensured through software solutions like PlagScan's originality verification through regular plagiarism checks and authorship verification.
