Evans High School is well-known for being an institution that strives for their students' excellence. The school is eager to prepare high school students for their further academic careers in colleges and universities. Evans High School was rated among the US's top high schools multiple times. To furtherly foster its efforts toward students, the high school decided in 2014 to start checking student papers for plagiarism and cheating.
